Social Role Valorization (SRV) theory is a powerful set of ideas useful in addressing the marginalization of people in society by supporting them to have access to the same good things in life enjoyed by typical people. The model program for the TPSID, Integrated Studies, was developed and continues to function using these ideas to make decisions about the program at Millersville University.

In an effort to provide an in-depth understanding of how SRV is applied to Integrated Studies, there is a [3 day training](#) being offered on [June 25, 26, & 27 at Millersville University](#). The training can be used for any human service worker, not just higher education. Technical support beyond the three days will be provided for implementation within your own program.
