Students enter college for many reasons. Most students are seeking to improve their chances of helping to acquire "[the good things of life](#)", one of which is getting a job! In our TPSID funded programs, most of our programs use mentors or coaches to provide intentional support to students who are pursuing part-time work experiences or internships while they are in college. The use of job coaches or mentors can be challenging, especially when resources are limited. What if you could save financial resources and build independence faster in your students alleviating the extensive use of the job coach? Read on to learn more about a technology hack that can help you to achieve this.

HP Reveal is a *free* app that allows you to create directions for the individual worker, allowing the job coach to fade quicker. The app allows the job coach and worker to create a short video that pairs instructions with photos, saving the project as an "aura" on the app. If you are interested, you can acquire a short demonstration video of how the app works by emailing atinfo@temple.edu. As you are considering your resources for the 2018-19 academic year, I would strongly suggest exploring the use of the app for students in your program.
