This term, taken from Dr. Wolf Wolfensberger's Social Role Valorization Theory (1984), can be understood in our inclusive postsecondary work as, "like a matriculating student would experience." With every decision that is made, program staff should ask "What does our college/university do for matriculating students?" In using this lens to make decisions, we operate our programs from a framework of full inclusion which promotes the use of existing resources and services on campus.
